### Education:

#### *Accomplishments*

1. Two students completed their graduation.
2. 21 students appeared in the High School Leaving Certificate conducted by State Board of Secondary Education, Manipur (BOSHEM), 2018.

#### *Goals*

1. Maximum number of children from Nursery to Class -Three will be enrolled in the Govt. School.
2. To avoid dropout students from school.

### Health & Hygiene:

#### *Accomplishments*

1. Conducted two day dental and general health camp for 309 sponsored children. Students were referred to Government Hospital for dental cases. Chalice child health records were maintain for monitoring their health status.
2. Construction of 40 IHHL cum bathroom under WASH project with the motive of maintaining proper sanitation and hygiene.

#### *Goals*

1. Children and adults maintained good personal hygiene by protecting themselves from various diseases.
2. To ensure good health of the sponsored children under Chalice Health fund.

### Nutrition:

#### *Accomplishments*

1. More number of sponsored families who has a space to cultivate are practicing kitchen gardening. Two of the sponsored families of YAI and one family from LAM have started turmeric and ginger farm.
2. With the initiative of YAI CCG members the mid-meals at the UJB, Govt. school are given regularly.
3. Many families are aware of the ill-effect use of chemical fertilizer, pesticides and insecticides and prefer practicing organic way of cultivation.

2. To follow up with the families to consume organic products.

## Community:

### Accomplishments

1. Constructed 40 IHHL cum bathroom under WASH project.
2. 30 toilets are being constructed at Yaipharok and 10 toilets at Sandanshenba Village.

## Goal

1. More number of toilets must be constructed in order to eradicate various diseases caused by open air defecation.
2. Increase the level of awareness among the CCGs to take up different skillful developmental programmes from Govt. Institutions and Organizations.

## Family:

### Accomplishments

1. Conducted two days training on food processing and marketing for enterprising members.
2. Home visit have been carried out to the family of the sponsored child who has family issues and help them out with the issue to the best we can.
3. Some numbers of the sponsored families have started earning by selling homemade pickle, dried fruits made from the seasonal fruits.
4. More new sponsored families Bank A/C were opened.

## Goal

1. Increase awareness on various livelihood skills so as to improve their sources of income.
2. Increase awareness on DFF sponsorship programme to the newly sponsored families.

## Direct Family Fund/ Chalice Circle Groups:

### Accomplishments

1. 25 Chalice Circle Groups have opened their saving Bank accounts.
2. Conducted three day residential training on book keeping for 38 leaders from 26 Chalice Circle Groups.
3. Hand holding training on records maintenance were given for those groups who were slow in learning.
4. Conducted Orientation on DFF sponsorship programme and the objective of Chalice Circle to the newly sponsored beneficiaries.
5. Chalice covenant was reviewed for all the old and new CCG members.
