



2017-2018 Annual Report: Cañete Site Site Under Sponsorship Cañete Noviciado Santa Ana Peru, Latin America

Education

Achievements

1. 320 sponsored student children and adolescents had: books, school supplies and materials needed for their studies, and 24 young people benefited from monthly payments for higher education.
2. Two workshops were held with the theme "Living the values in family and in the Community" where all the children sponsored from first grade of elementary school to the young people who are in higher education, were benefited and a weekly writing workshop, for boys, girls and adolescents according to the level of education and studies.
3. Repetition and failure of subjects in children with learning difficulties has been reduced by 10%.

Goals

1. Ensure that sponsored children and young people persevere and improve their school performance with the development of the life project.
2. Reduce the number of failed children and adolescents, through visits to educational institutions and family.

Health & Hygiene

Achievements

1. The provision of hearing equipment (hearing aids) for a deaf-mute girl and orthopedic materials for a child with paraplegia was provided. Both have now improved their living conditions.
2. Medicine was provided to 20 children and seniors, who due to their illness needed to consume medications in a regular manner for their treatment.
3. 20 children received physical, psychological and language therapies for a period of 6 months, with funds from the Gifts and Grant Catalogue.

Goals

1. Continue supporting children with special abilities and skills by providing medicines and/or therapies with funds from the sponsorship and Gift Catalogue.
2. Guide the improvement of eating practices with the consumption of iron-rich products, nutritious, locally grown and in adequate quantity, in addition to providing nutritional supplements to combat anemia in children, adolescents, youth and seniors.

Nutrition

Achievements

1. 550 families have prioritized the purchase of staple foods with DFF funds.
2. 35 mothers of sponsored children and seniors of the “Santa Ana” dining room, know and are aware of the importance of the prevention of malnutrition and anemia.
3. Nutritional diagnosis was made to 40 sponsored children of the “Santa Ana” dining room for their timely referral to specialists.

Goals

1. Promote that children, adolescents, young people and seniors have nutritious products in their daily diet.
2. Continue making the nutritional diagnoses of the beneficiaries for their timely referral to specialists and corresponding follow up.

Community

Achievements

1. Solidarity bonds between all the families of the Sponsorship were strengthened, sharing with the inmates of the Cantera Prison (Cañete) and other families who are in extreme poverty. In addition, it was possible to adapt the auditorium for cultural and religious activities for the prison population.
2. 95% of the sponsored families participated in workshops on Risk Management and First Aid. In addition, emergency backpacks were provided to 20 families, so they have them ready to face emergency situations.
3. 7 families, whose homes were affected by, fire, earthquakes and river overflows received the

Goals

1. Have school information regarding the development of our sponsors, through coordination relationships with tutors in the different Educational Institutions.
2. Hold workshops with some members of the CFC and extend the scope to the community such as the Cantera Prison, with topics related to: responsibility of parents, reintegration into the community, knowledge of sexuality, values, self-care and others, according to the target groups.

Family

Achievements

1. 85% of the sponsored families participated in the Workshops “living the values in family and in the Community”.
2. 100 children and young people prepared for the sacraments of Christian Initiation in their respective parishes.
3. 40 seniors participated in self-esteem workshops, seeking personal appreciation.

Goals

1. Train families on entrepreneurship topics.
2. Continue with the “living the values in family and in the Community” workshops

Direct Family Financing (DFF) / Chalice Family Circles

Achievements

1. 500 families have achieved individual savings.
2. 19 of 25 Circles of Family have group savings, in agreement with the BCP (Bank).
3. 63 leaders from different family circles were trained in leadership and good performance of roles and responsibilities.

Goals

1. Identify the areas that need to be improved and strengthened through the supervision of Family Circles.
2. Guidance on the discipline of savings, dialogue to be clear about the purposes of group savings and strengthen each family to be responsible for their money and future.
