Bulacan site works with children coming from the semi-urban sector of society. Still, poverty is a serious problem in our community. Our neighborhood is a complex composition of more than 15,000 poor, deprived and dysfunctional families.

I. Education:

Achievement:

1. 100% of our sponsored children are studying.
2. Last May 2018 – 14 of our Sponsored children have finished the tertiary level and are now looking for jobs.
3. Tutorial lessons conducted by our FWs during weekend to assist them in reading and comprehension.

Goals:

1. To sustain the tutorial lessons for the kids who need learning assistance.
2. To encourage the parents to wholeheartedly support their children especially in their school activities.

II. Health and Hygiene:

Achievement:

1. Height and Weight of children were taken and monitored.
2. Hygiene items are purchased by the family thru their DFF funds.

Goals

1. To sustain the health of the children thru proper food intake and vitamins
2. To constantly monitor the children's health and network with local health units for their medical concerns.

III. Nutrition

Achievement:

1. Food items are purchased by the family thru their DFF funds.
2. The site has no severely malnourished children anymore.

Goals:

1. To always remind the CCG groups to prioritize the nutritional needs of their children
2. To encourage CCG groups to try urban gardening.
3. To include in their meals the eating of Moringa/Malunggay leaves for its health and high nutritional benefit

IV. Family

Achievement:

1. Regular attendance to the CCG monthly meeting has been steady.
2. The families have become more confident in using the DFF paycards in purchasing their goods and needs of the family.
3. Conducted team building/leadership training of CCG members

Goals:

1. To inspire more the families on the dreams and ambitions of their children.
2. To give them insights and tips on how to improve and sustain their monthly meeting by encouraging them to participate in group discussion.

V. Community

Achievement:

1. Members of CCG groups are now more aware of their role.
2. The CCG groups have consistently undertaking their community service.
3. Community service includes feeding the children in the community, visiting sick and old people, visiting inmates in the municipal jail.

Goals:

1. To encourage the CCG community to plant “Malunggay/Moringa leaves in their vacant areas.
2. To encourage CCG members to make the habit of 3R’s – Re-use, Re

VI. Direct Family Funding

Achievement:

1. Families and their sponsored children have imbibed the rules of the DFF stated in their covenant.
2. Savings and subscription are regularly contributed by the members of the CCGs.
3. The CCG groups have opened their passbooks where they deposited their savings.

Goals:

1. To give them simple tips on how to save on everyday consumption from water,
2. electricity, food
3. To encourage every family to practice the 3R’s – Reduce, Reuse and Recycle
