



Our site's sponsorship program spans seven locations in two tribal villages, where public infrastructure is extremely under-developed and lacks basic resources such as schools, drinking water, irrigation systems, and adequate housing. In addition to sponsorship, the site provides capacity-building training for women and parents to promote income generation activities.



### Education

#### Goals

1. To ensure the maximum number of children are going to school.
2. To avoid students dropping out of school.

#### Achievements

1. One student completed their Bachelor of Arts from Manipur University.
2. 15 students took the High School Leaving Certificate exam. One got outstanding marks, six passed in first division, seven passed in second division, and one student failed.
3. 10 students took the Higher Secondary Education Examination, eight passed and one failed.

### Health & hygiene

#### Goals

1. To ensure that children and adults maintain good personal hygiene to prevent disease.
2. To ensure good health of our sponsored children.

#### Achievements

1. Conducted two days of Hepatitis and general health camps for 546 sponsored children. The children were screened Hepatitis and none of the children tested positive. Child health records were maintained for monitoring their health status.
2. We encouraged the utilization of toilets constructed under Chalice programs to eradicate open defecation and improve sanitation and hygiene.

### Nutrition

#### Goals

1. To increase the number of families that own small scale organic kitchen gardens and home farms and produce a good amount of traditional clothes.
2. Monitor the boarding school to provide a nutritious balanced diet to the children.



#### Achievements

1. Sponsored families were encouraged to engage in small scale organic cultivation in their kitchen garden and take up income generation activities in livestock and other activities.
2. Three families have started to engage in traditional method of weaving.
3. The supplementary education initiatives provides mid-day meals for the children. With the initiation, the children were given mid-day meals provided by the government which was not provided for many years.

### Community

#### Goals

1. To ensure that our beneficiaries have adequate housing.
2. Increase the level of awareness among our families to take up various skills developmental programs from government institutions and organizations and understand the need of the community to address the issues for positive outcomes.

#### Achievements

1. 10 houses were constructed for 10 families who were unable to build their own houses.
2. The community leaders started up a program to attain sustainability in village level developmental activities.
3. We have planted 500 tree saplings provided by the government department.

### Family

#### Goals

1. Increase awareness on various livelihood skills to improve family sources of income.
2. To orientate families in the sponsorship program to ensure all the families participate in program activities.



#### Achievements

1. The sponsored children's parents and families participate in Chalice programming.
2. The families have started to engage in organic cultivation in a small scale basis.
3. Home visits have been carried out to sponsored families whose children did not perform well in their academic and to pray for sickness.

### Family funding

#### Goals

1. Encourage other members of family circles to take up leadership roles and maintain their record books.
2. To increase the number of family circles participating in income generating activities.

#### Achievements

1. 31 family circles have their own group savings bank accounts.
2. We conducted two days of residential training on book keeping for 31 leaders.
3. Follow up orientation training on book keeping was provided.
4. The groups visited the sponsored children's schools, ensuring proper methodologies were provided to the students
5. Home visits were organized by family circles to pray for sickness.
