



Our site oversees the sponsorship program, in which academically talented boys and girls who come from poor families throughout Kenya are supported through post-secondary education alongside those of more privileged backgrounds. Sponsorship contributes to costs of boarding and educational materials.



Education

Goals

1. To ensure that all the sponsored students successfully graduate from their different universities.
2. To see to it that every sponsored student is comfortable through their studies by providing the basic needs needed through the process of studying.
3. To ensure that there are zero dropouts from school by any of our sponsored students.
4. To establish a closer relationship (mentorship) with our university beneficiaries to understand their needs better and challenges.

Achievements

1. All of our beneficiaries are now in different colleges and universities pursuing different courses of their desire. We have two beneficiaries who are studying abroad; in Switzerland and India.
2. 15 students have graduated with various degrees from different local universities in the last year. We are hopeful that our beneficiaries will be able to secure jobs in the already competitive market.
3. All the sponsored students have continued to receive money in the form of Family Funding. This has helped them take care of their day to day needs while in school.
4. Donated stationery to Imani and Grapesyard Children homes.
5. Renovated classroom doors for Muslim Primary School that guarantees safety of the pupils' school items when they go home after school.

Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To work closely with the Muslim Primary School cerebral palsy unit to help the students improve their motor skills and get a good education.
2. To ensure the community we serve gets access to better health facilities by improving the conditions in hospitals.

Achievements

1. Through gift catalogue funds, we donated medical equipment to learners at Muslim Primary School with cerebral palsy. This equipment included wheelchairs, spinal cosset, standing aid, training walker, arch support, polio boots and special seats.
2. We donated several learning materials including chairs and learning tables to the learners at Muslim Primary school cerebral palsy unit to help them improve their learning skills.

Nutrition

Goals

1. Initiate nutrition awareness campaigns in the communities we serve.
2. Have a feeding program at one of the needy primary schools in our community.



Achievements

1. Shared food baskets with two children's homes in Nairobi.
2. Shared a well balanced meal with two children's homes during Christmas celebrations.

Family

Goals

1. To intensify communication and participation of parents in the community activities we undertake.
2. To have awareness programs with parents especially on matters of health and nutrition.

Achievements

1. Site communication with beneficiaries' parents/guardians was positively embraced.
2. Parents expressed gratitude to Chalice sponsorship program for the support offered to their children, especially at Muslim Primary School.
3. We actively involved the parents for the cerebral palsy learners at Muslim primary during our donations at the unit.

Family funding

Goals

1. To empower families in the administration of their sponsorship funds and help them do proper budgets and savings.
2. To encourage families who receive funds to write good reports/letters to the sponsors and donors and include photos.

Achievements

1. All of our beneficiaries now have their own personal bank accounts where funds will be send directly to them.
2. Our beneficiaries have used the funds to take care of their personal needs especially school needs including paying school fees and hospital bills using Special Money.
