Our sponsorship program oversees sponsorship for both children and elders in seven locations, including a girls' and boys' hostel, a rehabilitation center for disabled children, and a home for elderly women who have no family or have been abandoned.



Education

Goals

1. To monitor the education of the children by appointing qualified teachers for tutorial support and by regular school visits.
2. To encourage and support the children to be goal oriented and to take up professional and technical studies to be self reliant.



Achievements

1. The tribal children are happy and became interested in going to school.
2. Quality education with competent teachers helped the children to score good results in the last academic year.
3. This year, 34 children completed high school education. They scored A+, A, B+, B, and few scored C grades. They will continue their higher secondary education.

Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To keep all sponsor children and the Elderly in good health and in normal BMI by July 2020.
2. To take up preventive measures and provide medicines to prevent diseases.

Achievements

1. Organised health check up camps where health recording is done by specialised doctors.
2. Three children with vision problems were provided with spectacles.
3. Elderly and children purchase needed personal hygiene products and medicine and they stay in a hygienic atmosphere.

Nutrition

Goals

1. To maintain the sound health of the elderly and the children and to provide them with nutritious food.
2. All the families must have kitchen gardens to cultivate good eating habits.



Achievements

1. All of the children and elderly are well nourished with nutritious food.
2. Training on kitchen gardens created a lot of interest in all three subsites.
3. 80% of families have their own organic kitchen gardens.

Community

Goals

1. To set up more facilities for income generation.
2. To encourage families to use the group savings funds for income generating activities.

Achievements

1. The community has become aware of the common needs in their community.
2. In our sub site CJH, the community came together and helped to re-construct the a house that was broken down by a storm.
3. The community has become more conscious of their health and cleanliness.

Family

Goals

1. To increase the number of livestock in every family and to motivate them to take up more income generating programs.
2. To educate all children in the families.



Achievements

1. Our MAN subsite built 13 houses for the homeless and poor families.
2. 120 families constructed houses and 270 made toilets with the government housing fund.
3. Family's living standards have improved and the savings increased. One family started to cultivate organic vegetable garden as income source.

Family funding

Goals

1. To empower families to be more responsible and accountable with the use of sponsorship funds.
2. To enable family circle groups to be more active, vibrant and co-operative for their development.

Achievements

1. Implementation of family funding increased the sense responsibility among the parents.
2. Family funding enabled the sponsored children and their sibling's education. Sometimes urgent medical needs are also met.
3. The family circle groups help members to be conscious of their social responsibility.
